SCHEME OF EXAMINATION FOR THE POST OF BEARER GRADE II

The Examination for recruitment to the post of Bearer Grade-II in the Rajya Sabha Secretariat shall consist of the following stages:-

Stage I. Written Examination

Stage II. Interview

1. WRITTEN EXAMINATION (100 Marks)

The Written Examination shall consist of only one paper having Objective-Type Multiple-Choice based questions. The details of the paper are as under:

Note:

- There shall be **NO** negative marking in the Written Examination.
- On the basis of marks obtained in the Written Examination, candidates will be shortlisted for the next stage of the recruitment process, *i.e.*, Interview.
- The marks secured by the candidates in the Written Examination shall be counted towards preparation of the final Merit List.
- Category-wise minimum qualifying percentage of marks in the Written Examination shall be as follows:

UR/EWS	OBC	SC/ST
50%	45%	40%

2. INTERVIEW (100 Marks)

- The Interview shall be structured to evaluate the overall personality of the candidates and to judge their suitability for the post. In the Interview, **due weightage would be given to candidates possessing desirable qualifications for the post as per its Recruitment Rules.**
- Interview shall be of **qualifying nature** only, *i.e.*, marks secured by the candidate in the Interview shall not be counted towards preparation of final Merit List. Category-wise minimum percentage of marks required for qualifying the Interview shall be as under:

UR/EWS	OBC	SC/ST
50%	45%	40%

- Candidates failing to secure the minimum percentage of marks in the Interview shall not be considered during preparation of final Merit List for the post.

3. MERIT LIST

Merit List shall be prepared based on the marks obtained in the Written Test (100 marks) only. Candidates eliminated at any stage of the recruitment process shall not be included in the final Merit List.
