## NOTICE

**Sub. : Important instructions for the candidates appearing in the Main Examinations for the posts of Secretariat Assistant (English/Hindi/Urdu) and Stenographer (English) - Advt. No. 1/2017- reg.**

Main Examinations for the posts of Secretariat Assistant (English/Hindi/Urdu) and Stenographer (English), advertised *vide* Advt. No. 1/2017, are scheduled to be held on 18<sup>th</sup> January and 19<sup>th</sup> January, 2020, respectively in the Parliament House Annexe, New Delhi. Candidates may download their Admit Cards through the link provided for the purpose on the website of Rajya Sabha.

2. Further, in this regard, the candidates of these two Examinations are directed to scrupulously follow the following instructions:

- (i) Candidates may kindly go through the 'General Instructions' printed on their Admit Cards and strictly follow the same during the said Examinations.
- (ii) It is reiterated that electronic gadgets/devices *viz.* mobile phones, chargers, charging cables, power banks, pen drives, smart watches, head/ear phones, Bluetooth devices, laptops, laptop chargers etc. are **not allowed inside the Parliament House Complex**. No arrangements to keep such items will be made and accordingly, candidates are advised **NOT** to bring any of such gadgets/devices on the examination day in the Parliament House Complex.
- (iii) Further, items like perfumes, deodorants, shaving razors, nail cutters, scissors, knife, briefcases, bags, *etc.* are also **NOT** allowed inside the Parliament House Complex. Candidates are, therefore, advised **NOT** to bring such items on the examination day in the Parliament House Complex.
- (iv) The candidates will be required to undergo certain security checks/protocols while entering the Parliament House Complex which may take some time. Accordingly, as stated in the instructions printed in the Admit Card, **candidates are again advised to report at the Reception Office of the Parliament House Annexe Building well in advance and in any case at least one hour before the scheduled start of their examination** to avoid any inconvenience during their entry to the examination venue.
